



McDonald's Kidathon 2026 Unites 6,000 Participants to Raise Funds for Sick Children

Celebrating *Ronald McDonald House Charities Hong Kong's 30th Anniversary* and
a Record-Breaking HK\$16.8 Million Raised in 2025

[April 18, 2026 - Hong Kong] — McDonald's Hong Kong's annual charity event, **the 17th "McDonald's Kidathon 2026,"** returned today to the Happy Valley Racecourse. To celebrate the 30th anniversary of Ronald McDonald House Charities Hong Kong (RMHC Hong Kong), Ronald McDonald House Prestigious Guardian Mr. Andy Lau made a surprise appearance — his first in 14 years—attending the event alongside Ronald McDonald House Ambassador Keung To@MIRROR and delighting thousands of participating parents and children. As a founding mission partner, McDonald's Hong Kong also announced at the event that the brand's cumulative fundraising total has now surpassed HK\$110 million. Furthermore, McDonald's Hong Kong successfully raised over HK\$16.8 million for RMHC Hong Kong in 2025, once again breaking its own record and setting the highest annual fundraising total to date.

Beyond the festive celebrations, Prestigious Guardian Andy Lau and Ambassador Keung To also took the opportunity to personally thank all benefactors who tirelessly support RMHC Hong

In addition to participating in the iconic charity song "Wingless Angel" and the filming of its remastered music video, they also made a special appearance at the McDonald's Kidathon 2026, bringing the event on a rousing success and offering immense encouragement to all participants and families of children in need. Looking ahead, we will continue to collaborate with all sectors of society, extending our care to more people in need and striving to create many more meaningful milestones together."

Ms. Grace Fung Oei, RMHC Global Board of Trustees and RMHC Hong Kong Chairperson remarked, "RMHC established Asia's first house in Hong Kong in 1996, and this year marks our 30th anniversary. We are incredibly grateful for McDonald's Hong Kong's continuous support in various ways over the past 30 years, which has allowed us to gradually expand from our first house in Sha Tin to our second house in Kwun Tong. As of March 2026, we have provided over 180,000 nights of accommodation for nearly 1,900 families, accompanying them on their recovery journey. We look forward to further expanding our services, so that ill children and their families can feel care and hope in this 'home away from home'."

In addition to making a surprise appearance to support the event, **Ronald McDonald House Prestigious Guardian Andy Lau**, together with **Ambassador Keung To**, performed the chorus of the RMHC Hong Kong's theme song, "Wingless Angel", on the spot. Through their moving voices, they aimed to spread love while sharing hope and positive energy with families and children in need. Afterwards, **Andy Lau** and **Keung To** joined recovered children who had appeared in the music video and previously stayed at RMHC Hong Kong for warm-up exercises. Accompanied by the four McDonaldland characters — Ronald, Grimace, Birdie and Hamburglar — as well as a group of Commercial Radio program hosts, including including Ah Jeng, Amber Au, Donald Tong, Elsie Lui, Eric Kot, Jan Lamb, Jim Yan, Josephine Ng, Ken Yuen, Sammy Leung, and 903 Producer German Cheung (names are listed in alphabetical order), the venue was filled with laughter as everyone prepared for the charity run.



Mr. Andy Lau, Ronald McDonald House Prestigious Guardian, shared, "On this special occasion of RMHC Hong Kong's 30th anniversary, I am truly delighted to once again participate in the McDonald's Kidathon. It is truly heartening to witness the unwavering and generous support shown by everyone over the years. I hope more children will continue to join this meaningful event in the future, helping us support even more seriously ill children."

Mr. Keung To, the Ronald McDonald House Ambassador, expressed, "I am honored to participate in the McDonald's Kidathon for the fourth consecutive year.
